## Article IV: Terms, Powers and Duties of the Officers

Section 1: President
a. The President is elected in February of every odd year for a two-year term beginning the following July. There is no term limit or intervening term requirement.
b. The President will receive compensation equivalent to the highest step at Grade 9 (currently Grade 9 Step 10 02/14/13)for a 260 day work year or their current District contract, if higher. The President will have all paid holidays identified in the CEA Negotiated Agreement.
c. The President shall be reimbursed for automobile expenses at the IRS mileage rate for travel for Association work. The president shall keep a daily mileage log recording the starting location, location(s) traveled to, and mileage driven for Association work, to be submitted monthly to the treasurer for board review and approval depending on membership being over 60\% FTE at the December and May Executive Board meetings. The monthly maximum reimbursement shall be $\$ 400$.
c. d. A President returning to a regular District position will return to their previous grade with all appropriate step increases and terms of service unless other factors contained in the contract at that time prevent this action from occurring.
d. e. The President shall be the Executive Officer of the Association.
e. f. The President shall preside over meetings of the Executive Board and of the Association.
f. g. The President shall appoint members to the standing committees and special committees and an ex-officio member of all standing committees.
g. h. The President shall represent the Association before the public, either personally or through delegates, and perform all other functions usually attributed to this office.
h. i. The President shall perform other duties as directed by the Executive Board.
i. j. The President shall be a Delegate at the NEA-Alaska Delegate Assembly and indicated as such in all NEA-Alaska Delegate Assembly election materials
j. k. The President shall be a Delegate at the NEA Representative Assembly and indicated as such in all CEA Representative Assembly election materials if the CEA Executive Board chooses to send representatives AND the President chooses to go.
k. 1. When the President position becomes vacant between elections, the remaining members of the Executive Board will appoint an Executive Board member as the President pro tempore for the remainder of the term.
